



SAFE SPORTING ENVIRONMENT GUIDING PRINCIPLE

Definitions:

1. "Duty of Care": is the requirement that reasonable care will be taken to avoid acts or omissions that could expose others to risk or harm.

Purpose

2. Swim Alberta believes that everyone in the sport has the right to enjoy the sport at whatever level or position they participate. All members and staff have the right to participate in a safe and inclusive training and competitive environment that is free of abuse, harassment or discrimination.
3. Swim Alberta believes the welfare of everyone involved in the sport is a foremost consideration and in particular the protection of children/athletes in the sport is the responsibility of each individual, member, club and special interest group in the swimming community.

Guiding Principle Statement

4. Swim Alberta provides a fun, healthy, inclusive and safe environment. Swimming enriches the lives of everyone involved by ensuring that the training and competitive environment is one where athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and staff know they are safe, and are treated with respect and dignity.

Ongoing Commitment to a Safe Sporting Environment

5. Swim Alberta, in understanding its Duty of Care, will ensure standards and procedures, based on best practices, support a safe, inclusive, open, observable and transparent sporting environment for all members.
6. The framework for Safe Sporting Environment focusses on the role, responsibility and practices of everyone involved in Swimming to ensure the safety of and development of athletes.
7. Swim Alberta programs and services will be consistent with and support the Safe Sporting Environment Guiding Principle.
8. Swim Alberta recognizes the critical role of the clubs and special interest group members in the delivery of Safe Sporting Environment programs initiatives.

Evaluation

9. Swim Alberta shall continually monitor and evaluate its policies, practices and procedures. Applicable policies may include and are not limited to:
 - i. Swim Alberta Code of Conduct and Ethics
 - ii. Coach Registration and Minimum Requirements Policy
 - iii. Screening Policy
 - iv. Discipline and Complaints Policy
 - v. Whistleblower Policy
 - vi. Club Membership Policy
 - vii. Special Interest Group Membership Policy
 - viii. Officials Registration and Membership Policy
 - ix. Eligible Board Candidates Policy
 - x. Equity Inclusion and Universal Access Guiding Principle
