Requirements for Meet Packages

All meets sanctioned by Swim Alberta must adhere to the Swim Alberta Competition Sanctioning Policy. The information below will assist you in developing meet packages that meet the requirements of the policy and guidelines.

The following information must be included in the meet information package:

Dates and Times of competition; Facility; Entry Deadline; Entry Fees; Entry Process; Seeding Information; Event List; Eligibility and Rules.

The following are standard clauses that must be included in meet packages sanctioned by Swim Alberta:

Rules

The meet will be conducted under published FINA and/or IPC rules and regulations supplemented by published and approved Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta rules and regulations. In addition, this meet package shall outline all changes to and specific application of the published rules. Swim Alberta policies and procedures, where appropriate will also apply.

Eligibility

This competition is open to all swimmers currently registered with Swimming Canada or a FINA affiliated club.

Scratches

The Swim Alberta scratch rule will be in effect for this competition.

Entry Process

All entries must be submitted through the Swimming Canada online system.

Deck entries will be limited to swimmers who have registered for the competition through the Swimming Canada online system.

Time Trials

Each registered swimmer member is permitted to compete in one individual or relay event. No entry fees are permitted for Time Trials.

All other items must follow the criteria set out in the Swim Alberta Competition Sanctioning Policy.
