

Alberta First – Funding for Alberta Post Secondary Swimmers

Swimmers who live in Alberta, train with a recognized Alberta Club and represent Alberta programs are eligible for Swim Alberta funding programs.

Swim Alberta offers the following funding programs to assist swimmers with the training and racing costs associated with high performance. Swimmers do not need to be attending university programs to access funding with the exception of the post secondary bursary* and the CIS Team Support* programs.

Varsity Programs

Alberta currently has three high quality varsity programs that participate annually at the Canadian Interuniversity Sport (CIS) Swimming Championships. Swimmers who have achieved Sport Canada funding through the Athlete Assistance Program receive full tuition to Canadian Universities.

An overview of scholarship and funding programs available to swimmers is outlined on the following page. Each school has a different funding model based on swimmer performance. Contact the head coach of each program for more information as to what specific options are be available.

Alberta University Scholarships

Scholarships and alumni support provide qualified swimmers up to full tuition and fees.

Jimmy Condon Scholarship (\$1,800 per year)

All varsity programs in Alberta offer the Jimmy Condon scholarship, which is equal to \$1,800 per year. Each varsity-swimming program can offer the scholarship to 15 men and 15 women annually.
