



2023-2024 Fees and Penalties

The swim season runs 1 September to 31 August; all memberships, regardless of when a member joins, expire on 31 August. Age is calculated as of 31 December for registration fees.

Affiliation fees:

Year round swim club – Not for Profit	=	\$435.00
Varsity teams	=	\$218.00
Masters swim club (20+ members)	=	\$65.00
Masters swim club (11-19 members)	=	\$43.50
Masters swim club (<10 members)	=	\$21.75

Swimmer fees: Participants in all affiliated club run programs must be registered with Swim Alberta.

Penalties and Fines

As the governing body for competitive swimming in Alberta, Swim Alberta will enforce penalties and fines as it relates to sanctioned competitions and non-compliance with registration.

Non-Registered Swimmer (entered into sanctioned competitions) = \$100 per swimmer/event.

Suspended Clubs due to non-compliant coaches = \$100 per athlete entered into the competition.
