### **AFFILIATION**

The ASSA and Swim Alberta approve all summer member clubs in the province. The ASSA and Swim Alberta member Club's agree to abide by all policies, rules and regulations as well as the bylaws of the ASSA (<u>Bylaws & Policies</u>) and Swim Alberta (<u>Bylaws & Policies</u>). As a summer member club you need to familiarize yourself with the ASSA Rules & Regulations and Policies & Procedures and all Swim Alberta policies. Ensure you have read and understood the ASSA Membership Renewal policy and the Swim Alberta Club Membership Renewal Policy.

Affiliation and registration information is available on the ASSA website.

### Forms:

Forms available on the Swim Alberta website can be downloaded as fillable PDF's. They must be saved onto a computer, electronically completed, and re-saved before being uploaded to the online affiliation application.

Access to the national registration, tracking, and results (RTR) database is provided through the submission of waiver forms for club's registrars, treasurers, and club officials administrators. Links to waiver forms are provided below and must be uploaded to the online affiliation application form.

### **Waiver Forms**

<u>Club Registrar Waiver</u> - REQUIRED (Submit to Swim Alberta through the Club Affiliation Application)

To be used for your club registrar to have access to the registration system.

<u>Club Officials Administrator Waiver</u> - REQUIRED for year round clubs/OPTIONAL for masters clubs (Submit to Swim Alberta through the Club Affiliation Application)

To be used for your club officials administrator to have access to the registration system.

<u>Treasurer Waiver</u> - OPTIONAL (Submit to Swim Alberta through the Club Affiliation Application) To be used for your club treasurer to have access to the registration system.

### FAQ's

### **Affiliation Form & Fees:**

Where can I find the affiliation application form?

Affiliation is open to returning clubs who were in good standing at the end of the previous swim season. The affiliation application form is online and the link is shared with returning clubs directly via email.

How do I pay the affiliation application fee?

The affiliation application fee for the current swim season is \$76.00. The fee can be made using Visa or Mastercard when submitting the completed online application or a cheque can be mailed to Swim Alberta, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, 11759 Groat Road, Edmonton, AB, T5M 3K6.

Clubs are not considered members until a fully completed affiliation application and the fee have been received by Swim Alberta.

Why do we have to list all members of our Board of Directors?

Swim Alberta provides Directors and Officers Liability Insurance to those persons named on the current seasons affiliation submission.

### **Required Documentation:**

What is Proof of Filing?


As a non-profit (not for profit), you are required to submit a Proof of Filing application to Corporate Registries on an annual basis. The Proof of Filing documentation required as part of affiliation is the confirmation that is returned to the club after the application has been approved.

What are stamped bylaws?

Bylaws are the rules of your club. As a non-profit (not for profit) your club must have bylaws registered with Corporate Registries. Once approved, Corporate Registries will stamp your bylaws and return a copy to the club.
