

ASSA RECORDS



PROVINCIAL RECORDS

Only official results from ASSA, Swim Alberta or Swimming Canada sanctioned swim meets occurring during the summer swimming season shall be eligible for Provincial Records.

In ASSA standard individual events, official results shall be eligible for Provincial Records provided the swimmer was participating in the appropriate age category, a birth certificate may be requested by the ASSA to verify athlete age.

In ASSA standard relay events, official results shall be eligible for Provincial Records provided all four swimmers participating on the team in question were in the appropriate age category, birth certificates may be requested by the ASSA to verify the athletes' age.

The ASSA shall deliver Provincial Records certificates to be signed by the president and delivered to the region reps no later than the fall meeting.

ASSA ALL STAR TEAM RECORDS

All Star Team records shall be maintained in all individual events offered at the Swim Alberta Age

Group & Senior Championships Long Course meet(s) according to the following age groups:

- a) 10&U
- b) 12&U
- c) 13&14
- d) 15-17

Official results shall be eligible for All Star Team records provided the swimmer was participating in the appropriate age category according to the meet's age deadline; a birth certificate may be requested by the ASSA to verify athlete age.

To establish a record, the existing record time must be tied or bettered.

Records will be granted based on the submission of the official results from meets with All Star Team participants to the ASSA or Swim Alberta Office.
