

Regional Assignment

PURPOSE

Regions serve the purpose of dividing the membership into groups based on their geographical location to facilitate conducting meets during the summer swimming season and the hosting of Regional Championships.

NUMBER AND NAME OF REGIONS

There are six (6) Regions, named alphabetically as “Region A” through “Region F”
The number of Regions may be changed upon resolution of a majority of the Board of Directors

ASSIGNMENT TO A REGION

New and renewed Clubs will be assigned to a Region by the Board of Directors in accordance with the following guidelines:

1. Regions shall be as equal as possible in the number of Clubs,
2. Regions shall be as equal as possible in the number of Swimmers,
3. Location of Clubs will be considered such that travel distances within a Region are minimized when possible.

Existing Clubs’ Region assignment may be changed to better meet the Region assignment guidelines as outlined above upon resolution of a majority of the Board of Directors.

REVIEW OF REGION ASSIGNMENT

The Board of Directors shall review the assignment of Clubs to a Region at the fall Board of Directors meeting in years hosting a winter Olympic Games, in accordance with the Assignment of new and renewed clubs, and re-assignment of returning clubs shall be completed at or prior to the spring Board of Directors meeting.

The attached map is a general boundary line and can change pending a review on the terms of this policy.
