

Swim Alberta Officials Dress Code

Officials on deck at any sanctioned Swim Alberta competition should be dressed according to the Officials Dress Code.

For the 2021-2022 Season – Swim Alberta Provincial Competitions – Referees and Starters will be in red polo shirts. All other officials will be in white polo shirts. For meets outside of the Swim Alberta Provincial Competitions Referees and Starters may choose to wear red or white polo shirts. All other officials must wear white.

As of September 2022 – All officials except timers and chief timekeepers, will be in red polo shirts. All timers will be in white polo shirts.

The dress code red or white t-shirt or polo shirt has no images, logos or symbols (exception for a small symbol on the chest, for example a Swim Alberta logo or a club logo), black pants, shorts, capris or skirt and appropriate footwear for the pool deck (no outdoor shoes).
