This season has also been one that has brought about change, both in how the organization operates, but also who is helping to work with us and lead us forward. ## HIGH PERFORMANCE COACH REPORT

Goal: To improve the performances of Alberta Swimmers in the national and international arenas.

The 2012 Olympic Games are over. The games will be always remembered as the last games for Michael Phelps, who through his career won 18 gold medals and 22 medals. Canada won two medals. Brent Hayden won bronze in the 100 free and Ryan Cochrane won silver in the 1500 free. Overall, Canadian swimmers competed in seven finals and numerous semi-finals. The only Alberta based swimmer that competed in a final was Amanda Reason, who was a member of the 4x200 free relay which placed fourth.

Through the summer there were numerous swimmers from Alberta clubs representing Canada internationally at different meets. The swimmers and meets were:

2012 North American Challenge: Meaghan Morter (AMAC), Hunter Balch, Jennifer Morgan, Georgia Kidd, Emily Flowers (all OSC), Lili Margitai, Sophia Saroukian, Ryder McGinnis (all EKSC), Alana Skocdopole (RDCSC), Anthony Lyons, Kevin Nelson, Taryn Pratt (all CASC), Jonathan Brown (NCSA)

On the domestic level Alberta clubs showed strength at both the Age-Group and Senior National levels. At the Age-Group Nationals in Calgary, Alberta had three teams in top rankings, CASC placed second, OSC third, and EKSC ninth.

At the Senior Nationals in Edmonton, Alberta also had three teams in top 10, EKSC placed third, CASC fifth, and UCSC seventh.

The University of Calgary varsity teams, both men and women, had strong performances at the 2012 CIS meet. The women's team finished second and the men's team third.

### International Competitions

#### Senior International

2012 Olympic Games, London, July/August 2012

As mentioned, the Olympic Games were the major competition of the summer and three swimmers from Alberta were on the team.

Amanda Reason who joined the University of Calgary Varsity Team and UCSC in 2012, had the best results in London. Amanda qualified for the Olympics on the 4x200 Free Relay. At the Games, Amanda with Brittany Maclean, Samantha Cheverton and Barb Jardin had a great performance, placing fourth.



Erica Morningstar placed 17 in the 200 IM, a disappointing result based on expectations prior to the meet. Jillian Tyler placed 14 in the 100 Breast, seven-tenths slower than the time she swam at Trials.

#### Junior/Youth International

2012 Junior Pan-Pacific Games, Honolulu, August, 2012

2012 North American Challenge, Edmonton, August 2012

As part of junior and youth development, the best Canadian junior and youth swimmers were selected to represent Canada at the North American Challenge. This was the sixth year for this competition. The meet was held in Edmonton and Canadian team showed very strong performances. Alberta was represented by swimmers from five different clubs across the province. For many, the meet was their first Canadian national team experience, a great accomplishment and stepping stone to future Canadian national teams.

#### Swim Alberta Team Tours

##### Prospects West

Swimmers from Alberta, British Columbia, Saskatchewan and Manitoba travelled to Montreal to watch and experience the 2012 Olympic Trials. They trained together two times a day, listened to swimming related presentations and were able to experience the Olympic Trial meet. The trip finished with a time-trial meet in the Olympic pool, all provinces bringing their best 14 and under swimmers.

North South Dual/Camp 11 & 12, Edmonton, April 2012

This was the fifth year and involved more than one hundred swimmers. As in the past, the meet and camp were good experiences for all the young swimmers and coaches involved. This Swim Alberta initiative involved a brief training period that included great technical and skill sessions.

#### Technical program

On the technical side, Swim Alberta continued with several established programs from the previous years

#### Provincial Stroke Camps

The camps program has been successfully running for several years. Through the seasons the camps have impacted a large number of swimmers throughout the province, having a huge influence on the development of competitive swimming across Alberta. This season there were two initiatives. The first one in October was held in Calgary, and the second was in Edmonton in May

HP Development Fund

The High Performance Development helps encourage and provides support to swimmers that are within the FINA A + 2% time. There were close to a dozen recipients of this funding. For the most part the funding was used for the activities in the first part of the season.

Open Water Elite Funding

Swimmers who finish in the Top 16 at the World Championships in this Olympic event are eligible for \$3000.00 in training support. As a part of the open water program Nadine Williams represented Alberta at the World Championships in Shanghai.

Future

In 2012–2013 there will be great opportunities to represent Canada internationally. The Canadian senior teams will compete at the 2013 World Championships in Barcelona and the 2013 World University Games in Kazan, Russia. Junior swimmers will be selected for the World Junior Swimming Championships held in Casablanca in Morocco. Alberta will select a team for the 2013 Canada Games in Sherbrooke. As in past years, expectations are that Alberta will have a large number of swimmers competing for Canada next summer.

Finally, I would like to thank all the coaches, officials, parents, and all other supporters who made this season's successes possible. Also, very special thanks and good luck to James Hood, who is leaving Swim Alberta after fifteen years as general manager.

## TECHNICAL OFFICER REPORT

The position of technical officer delivers the technical program for the Alberta Coaches Council and Swim Alberta. The duties include rankings, stroke camps, tour teams, funding, provincial meets and coach education.

### Youth Recognition

During the short course season a total of 169 athletes were recognized with the youth recognition award. There were 28 swimmers aged 10 and under who achieved the Top 5 award. In the 11-17 year old age groups there were 19 individuals achieving Top 1 recognition, 76 achieved Top 10 and 46 earned the Top 25 award. The long course season had a total of 189 total recipients. The 10 and under category had a total of 30 recognized swimmers. The 11-17 year olds saw 15 individuals achieve Top 1 standing while 76 and 68 made the Top 10 and Top 25 awards respectively.

### Camps

#### Fall Stroke Camp

The top 32 ranked swimmers aged 13-16 in the province participated in the Calgary camp October 7-9, 2011. Swimmers who achieved youth recognition were also invited to join in the dry land activities and swim one session with the stroke coaches. In addition swim training the groups received nutrition education, video analysis of their starts and other team building activities.

#### Para Swimming Camp

On December 9-12, 2011 Swim Alberta held its first second Para Camp combined with Special Olympics Alberta in conjunction with the Can Am meet in La Mirada, California. Nine swimmers and three coaches attended the camp, which was run by Janet Dunn, Swimming Canada's Para Swimming Development Coach. Special thanks to the Alberta Cerebral Palsy Sport Association, Special Olympics Alberta, the Capital Region Alberta Sport Development Centre and Swimming Canada for providing funding for the camp.

### Tour Teams

#### Alberta North versus South

Sixty-four swimmers aged 11-12 qualified to attend the event held at Kinsmen in Edmonton. An addition to the camp format was the inclusion of the provincial stroke coaches in attendance to give feedback to the personal coaches in attendance. The event included mental skills, dry land training; two pool training sessions and the dual meet. A youth recognition camp was also offered for swimmers in the Northern Region.

### Prospects West

For 2012 the camp was offered during Olympic Trials in March for the qualified 13-14 year old swimmers. The camp participants had the opportunity to train in the Olympic pool and observe finals each evening. The event is a joint camp with British Columbia and a combined team from Manitoba & Saskatchewan. The participants had seven-pool training sessions, a competition plus video analysis and other education sessions.

### Alberta Summer Games

A record number of swimmers attended the 2012 Alberta Summer Games. The event included record numbers at the zone trials. There were 237 participants at the games and highlights included four new Canadian Age Group Championship qualifiers. Congratulations to Zone 2 for winning the games.

### Provincial Meets

Provincial meet numbers continue to grow and are continually being reviewed by the Alberta Coaches Council, 2012 saw record numbers at every level.

Age Group Trials Long Course: 314 swimmers, 65 new A qualifiers

Senior Championships Short Course: 253 swimmers

Age Groups Short Course: 428 swimmers

### Coach Education

Over the past year nine Swim 101 courses ran with 123 participants towards their first level of certification. Medicine Hat hosted Swim 201 with eleven participants. Swim 301 was offered in Airdrie with ten coaches attending.

Carl Simonson (OSC), Scott Wilson (EKSC), Bill Humby (UA), Colin Beattie, Amanda Little, and Heather Larson (all from PENGU) received monies from the fund. The board received many applications from Northern Region coaches and the new board will determine if the program will continue. The projects proposed by these recipients were varied and the NR board felt the best use of funds for the development of our coaches.

An official's clinic was held in October 2011 organized by the NR Officials Chair, Glennis Mossey. These clinic days have been progressively declining in attendance and the board has expressed its interest in looking at new delivery models to better serve the busy member clubs. It is imperative that we reach out to our official's base and meet their developmental needs as we cannot run efficient and effective swim meets without a well-trained pool of volunteers. Northern Region will be welcoming a new Officials Chair for the 2012 - 2013 as long time member, Glennis Mossey, has chosen to step down after countless years of exemplary service to the board. Northern Region acknowledges and thanks Glennis for this huge contribution!

Finally, the board is in the final stages of divesting itself of equipment with the sale of it's Ares units, speakers and computers housed at the Kinsmen Sports Centre to the City of Edmonton. This has been a long term goal of the board to focus more on personnel development rather than equipment maintenance and inventory.

### Long Range Planning Subcommittee

The results of the survey sent to all clubs indicated that a higher profile was required by Swim Alberta and that coaching changes affected swimmers and their commitment to the sport. Work is still to be done on defining funding parameters for SR.

### 2012 Canadian Age Group Championships

Southern Region and Swimming Canada co-hosted the 2012 Canadian Age Group Championships in Calgary during July 25 – 30th. The five day pool competition saw close to 1600 athletes in attendance at Talisman Centre, with another 175 athletes in the open water competition at Arbour Lake on the final day of the event, from over 180 clubs across Canada. Cheryl Humphrey was Meet Chair. More than 120 volunteers each day provided their time and knowledge to ensure a successful competition for swimmers, coaches, support staff and officials during the six day championships. In addition to providing a technically proficient competition, the Local Organizing Committee, comprised of members from across the region provided athletes, coaches and visitors with additional services to ensure an exceptional experience. This included an outdoor athlete/coach area; athlete snacks; information booths; access to Calgary Food Trucks and sponsor vendors – Esquire T-shirts and Team Aquatics; as well as an outdoor hospitality area. Each gold medal winner received a coveted white cowboy hat, in the tradition of Calgary's western hospitality – these hats were certainly sought after in addition to the gold medals. A big thank you to the Local Organizing Committee as well as the hundreds of volunteers that helped ensure a top quality Canadian Age Group Championships for all.

The ASSA also seems to be more accepting of masters this year and there were fewer issues since the removal of the unattached masters category. We hope this improvement and increase in the positive feedback regarding masters swimming in ASSA will prove to carry over into next year and provide even greater opportunity for masters swimmers during the summer of 2013.

We would like to congratulate and welcome Nancy Black in her new role as Executive Director of Masters Swimming Canada. To date we have found increased communication and initiative from the National body and look forward to increased opportunity and support from them in the near future.
