President and Executive Director Message

With a start of a new swim season upon us, we look back on the 2016-2017 competitive season and celebrate the many achievements of our athletes, coaches, clubs and Swim Alberta as an organization.

Our athletes were represented on a number national teams, including senior, junior and para. The major international competitions this year included the 2017 FINA World Championship (Rachel Nicol – LASC); 2016 FINA World SC Championships (Rachel Nicol – LASC, Jason Block – UCSC, Peter Brothers - UCSC); 2017 FISU Games (Danica Ludlow – UCSC); 2017 FINA World Junior Swimming Championships (Alexander Pratt – CASC). Unfortunately, the 2017 World Para Swimming Championships were postponed due to the earthquakes in Mexico (Morgan Bird – CASC).

Team Alberta (Swimming) sent 32 swimmers and seven staff to the 2017 Canada Summer Games which were held August 5 – 13 in Winnipeg. Swimming earned a total of 38 medals at the games in addition to seeing 11 Alberta provincial records broken and 4 National Age Group Records set. Cole Pratt was Alberta's Flag Bearer at the Closing Ceremonies, achieving 10 medals at the games and leading the charge in setting 10 new provincial records and 4 Canadian Age Group National Records.

Over this past year, Swim Alberta undertook extensive consultations with the membership and stakeholders to develop a strategic plan that will guide the organization over the next several years. The mission of Swim Alberta is to: "govern, lead and support competitive swimming", with an eye to a vision of "Every swimmer has the opportunity to reach their full potential". Three strategic directions will focus the work of Swim Alberta over the next 8 year period and include: Provide programs, services and support to maximize all aspects of competitive swimming; Lead and inspire a culture of professionalism; Create growth and lifelong opportunities through an inclusive membership.

Working in partnership with our clubs, coaches and stakeholders over the next several years, will help us achieve what we have set out in the 2017-2024 Strategic Plan. In the fall of 2016, the Swim Alberta board undertook a financial sustainability review as a critical and necessary part of the strategic planning process. The review included an in-depth look at our current financial picture, future program and services needs as well as the identified financial risks to the organization.

A new provincial competition format was launched in 2016-2017. The review for this competition structure was completed the previous year in consultation with the Alberta Coaches Council, High Performance Advisory Committee to align the provincial competitions to the national calendar and long course season. A review of the changes implemented in 2016-2017 was completed and modifications were made for the upcoming 2017-2018 year.

The past year also saw the organization review and put in place new structures for operations. This included realigning staffing and committee structures to ensure Swim Alberta has the foundations for continued growth of the sport as well as ensuring strong leadership of our operational committees.

On behalf of the board and staff of Swim Alberta – thank you to the many athletes, coaches, volunteer officials, volunteer club board members and staff for the continued contribution you make to the sport of swimming and the swimming community. We look forward to another year of success and growth in 2017-2018, through our continued partnerships with all of you.

PROVINCIAL PROGRAMS

Swim Alberta Camps & Tours

Discover

The discover camp series ran in partnership with the Alberta Sport Development Centre (ASDC) in both Edmonton and Calgary. The three one-day camp series included testing, training and education for 40 athletes in the north and 40 athletes in the south. The camps included coach information sessions with dryland experts provided by the ASDC.

Emerge

In December of 2016 Swim Alberta sent 20 swimmers to Richmond, BC to attend the Rapds FastSwim Classic. The competition provided a back to back weekend racing opportunity for many of Alberta's up and coming athletes.

Aspire

This years event was combined with Alberta's 2017 Canada Summer Games Team. The event was held in conjunction with Swim BC, Swim Saskatchewan and Swim Manitoba with the event name of Prospects West. Athletes were provided training, education and race video as well as attending the first two days of the Mel Zajac International. A total of 29 athletes and five coaches attended Aspire Alberta.

Excel

Alberta's top swimmers selected for Excel attended the Arena Pro Series Santa Clara in early June. During this timeframe a number of swimmers eligible for the Excel tour were also selected for Swimming Canada camps. Three swimmers attended the competition led by Coach Dave Johnson.

Para Swimming Day

On November 5-6, 2016 Swim Alberta and Swimming Canada ran para swimming program in Edmonton and Calgary. The program provided a regional classification opportunity, a grassroots exposure for new para swimmers, and a coach information session. The regional format had six (6) classified swimmers, eight (8) swimmers in the exposure camp, and a total of seven (7) coaches attending the information session. The camps were run by Janet Dunn, Swimming Canada's Para Swimming Development Coach.

2017 Alberta Summer Games

Team Alberta sent 32 swimmers and seven staff to the 2017 Canada Summer Games which were held August 5-13 in Winnipeg, MB.

Alberta swimmers broke 11 Provincial Records, and 4 National Age Group Records. Avery Wiseman set a new Provincial Record in 200m Breaststroke with a time of 2:30.33, which was also a new Canada Summer Games record held for 16 years by Annamay Pierse. Cole Pratt set 10 new Provincial Records in 200 Fly (2:03.42), 100 Free (52.66), 100 Back (56.82), 200 Free (1:54.04), 100 Fly (55.65), and 200 IM (2:05.26), 4 of these records also being new Canadian Age Group National Records (200 Fly, 100 Back, 200 Free and 200 IM).

Swimming earned a total of 38 medals for the overall total of 97 medal for Team Alberta; 27 Individual Medals (13 Gold, 4 Silver, 10 Bronze), 5 Relay Medals (1 Gold, 2 Silver, 2 Bronze), 2 Para-Swimming Medals (1 Gold, 1 Silver), and 3 Special Olympics Medals (2 Silver, 1 Bronze).

Youth Recognition

During the short course season a total of 99 athletes were recognized with the youth recognition award. There were 22 swimmers aged 10 and under who achieved the Top 5 award. In the 11-17 year old age groups there were 8 individuals achieving Top 1 recognition while 69 achieved Top 10. The long course season had a total of 130 total recipients. The 10 and under category had a total of 19 recognized swimmers. The 11-17 year olds saw 8 individuals achieve Top 1 ranking while 103 made the Top 10 award.

PROVINCIAL COMPETITIONS

The 2016-2017 was an exciting year for provincial competitions with the launch of a new competition format. The format saw revised qualifications, meet format and the first December provincial competition with the Swim Alberta Cup. The breakdown of participants is below.

COMMITTEES OF SWIM ALBERTA

Alberta Coaches Council (ACC)

The Alberta Coaches Council is elected by the coach membership in Alberta. The ACC provides advise and consultation for the format of the provincial meets, tour teams, stroke camps and funding programs. The ACC also endeavors to provide coach education and mentorship opportunities to the coaches of Alberta. During this past season, the ACC and the HPAC have worked together to develop a new terms of reference forming a single committee called the Alberta Technical Program Committee (ATPC). High Performance Advisory Committee (HPAC)

HPAC is an appointed committee of Alberta. HPAC is responsible for the oversight and guiding the development of High Performance athlete technical programs, which includes funding, competition structure oversight, technical programs and related systems and structures (IST) to support identified high performance swimmers in the province of Alberta.

Alberta Officials and Competition Committee (AOCC)

The Alberta Officials Committee is responsible for the development of swimming officials at all levels in Alberta. This includes year round swimming, Alberta Summer Swimming Association, Para Swimming and Masters Swimming. The committee organizes officiating clinics throughout the year, supports the training and development of referees and provides ongoing guidance to officials. The committee adopted revised terms of reference in January of 2017 to align with the National committee structure. Committee members include: Jennifer Flowers (Chair), Steve Brown, Lockie Lister, Andre Harpe (ASSA), Doug Bird, Patti Clarkson and Rob Farmer.

Alberta Masters Swimming Committee

The Alberta Masters Swimming Committee is an operational and technical committee of Swim Alberta, which works with swimmers who are 18 years of age or older. The committee is an advisory committee that guides masters swimming, provides oversight for the Masters Provincials and other initiatives that focus on masters swimming. The committee members include: Carli Tyson, Dave Amundrud, Grant Andruchow.


PARTNERS OF SWIM ALBERTA





2016-2017 REVENUE AND EXPENSES OVERVIEW
