ASPIRE ALBERTA 2022-2023

Purpose: To provide opportunities for training, race preparation & analysis, and competition (dependent upon the time of year) so as to expose aspiring swimmers to the level of expectation required to compete internationally. Focus will be on skill race analysis under pressure. The overarching goal is to provide a distinct uplift in experience beyond a normal daily training or typical racing environment.

Camp Dates TBC: June 1-7, 2022 (including Mel Zajac Invitational) - BIG 4 Challenge with BC, ON & QC tour teams with scoring

Location: Vancouver, BC

Participation Fee: \$625

Eligibility:

Swimmers must complete the Declaration of Intent prior to the last day of the selection period and must swim events used for selection in the selection period to be eligible.

Athlete Selection:

Age as of March 2, 2023: Females 15 & under/ Males 16 & under

Number of swimmers: up to a maximum of 20 Swimmers regardless of gender.

Selection Period:

March 2 to April 2, 2023

(Start of the Swim Alberta Provincial Championships to the end of 2023 Bell Canadian Swimming Trials)

Selection:

Will be made using each swimmer's best individual Points score. Each swimmer's score will be based on the swimmer's age as of the start of the selection period. If two swimmers are tied for the same Swim Alberta On-Track Points, the next highest points will be calculated until the tie is broken. Swimmers who have qualified for Emerge Alberta will choose one or the other camp (Emerge or Aspire).

Coach Selection:

The Provincial Technical Director or a Sport Development Director will act as Team Lead. At least three coaches will be selected by invitation from Swim Alberta. Coaching staff layout will be determined on a camp-to-camp basis. Team Manager(s) will be appointed by Swim Alberta.
