

2022 Canada Summer Games Coach Selection Criteria

Required Dates: June 1-5, 2022 (Tentative: Vancouver with Aspire Alberta Tour)
July 10-11 (Equipment, Edmonton)
August 1-5 (Tentative: Staging in Ontario)
August 5 to 14 (Canada Games, St. Catharines, ONT)

Competition dates: August 7 to 13

Competition Location: St. Catharines, Ontario

Coaching Staff: 5 (at least one must be a female)

Eligibility:

- All Participants MUST be vaccinated: Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the Canada Games Council (CGC), with the endorsement of the 2022 Canada Games Host Society, will implement a mandatory COVID-19 vaccination policy for all accredited individuals at the 2022 Canada Summer Games in the Niagra Region. - All coaches must be registered with Swimming Canada and be a member of the CSCA.
- All coaches must be members in good standing with Swim Alberta.
- All coaches must meet the coach certification requirements as outlined in the Canada Summer Games swimming technical package.
- All selected coaches must fill out the declaration of intent by midnight, Monday, March 21, 2022
- Eligible coaches may either be the Coach of Record of a qualified athlete as per the [Swim Alberta Coach of Record Policy](#) or be part of the Swim Alberta Future Coaches.
- At this time Swim Alberta does not have a vaccination policy, this is subject to change. All participants including swimmers, coaches, team managers, etc. must adhere to any vaccination or testing requirements stated by Canada Games/Team Alberta. More info can be found at www.canadagames.ca

Declaration of Intent:

Coaches must complete the online 'Declaration of Availability' form prior to Midnight, Sunday, April 24, 2022. Coaches not completing the declaration will not be eligible for selection <https://www.tfaforms.com/4951623>

Selection Process:

The coach of record of the swimmer who has the highest total of number one ranked swims, based on the Swimmer Selection Criteria, will be selected as the Head Coach. The highest total number of next highest rankings will be used to break a tie if required. Interested coaches must have declared intent by submitting the coach of record document by April 24, 2022.



Excellence, Integrity, Innovation, Collaboration

Up to one further coach who has the next highest total of number one ranked swims, based on the Swimmer Selection Criteria, may be selected as a coach. The remaining coaches may be selected from the Swim Alberta [Future Coaches Program](#) to coach the 24 able-bodied swimmers and four (4) Para swimmers. The Swim Alberta Technical Staff and the Canada Summer Games Head Coach will select the coaches. This appointment shall be at the sole discretion of Swim Alberta.

One coaching position will be selected to coach the Special Olympic Swimmers and will be selected by Special Olympics Alberta.

In the event that the coaching staff cannot be filled using this selections process then the two Sport Development Directors shall in consultation with the 2022 Canada Summer Games Team Head Coach, appoint coaches to the team to fulfill the positions.
