

## NATIONAL JUNIOR TEAM SUPPORT *2021-2022*

### **Alberta First**

All funding programs will be limited to athletes living in Alberta, training in Alberta and representing an Alberta program on a year-round basis.

### **Purpose**

The National Junior Team Support Fund is to support athletes with off-setting the program costs for designated Junior National team (Swimming Canada) for which they have been selected.

### **Eligible Athletes**

Athletes representing an Alberta program who have qualified for the Swimming Canada National Junior Team. Athletes must represent an Alberta program at the Canadian Swimming Trials and/or the Canadian Swimming Championships and be training in Alberta on a full-time basis. The Swimming Canada National Junior Team is defined as the designated National Junior Team event for the season.

### **Program**

Athletes qualifying for the National Junior Team will have access to a share of \$6,000, up to a maximum of \$1,000. Funds will be paid to the athlete's home club to be deposited into the swimmer's account or paid directly to the swimmer at their request or request of parent/guardian.

### **Program Timeline**

Swimmer qualifies for the National Junior Team support at the National Junior Team Selection Competition. Coach and swimmer notified by Swim Alberta as to eligibility and payout.

### **Designated Teams**

Swimming Canada National Junior Team events include either the FINA World Junior Championships or the Junior Pan Pacific Championships. The designated team is to be confirmed by Swimming Canada.
