



2020 Para Prospects West

Purpose

To provide a camp opportunity for para-swimmers and coaches from the four western provinces that provides education, training and to grow the para community in Western Canada.

Dates

- February 5-8, 2020

Location

- Edmonton, Alberta

Participation Fee

- Participation fees will be set and invoiced by each respective province.

Eligibility

- Swimmers must be eligible for the 2021 Canada Summer Games based on year of birth (1996 to 2008), residency, and citizenship requirements.
- Not currently identified by Swimming Canada's NextGen program and have not represented Canada at WPS LC World Championships, Para-Pan Am Games, Para-Pan Pacs, or Paralympics.
- Registered as a competitive member with a Swimming Canada year-round club.

Athlete Selection

- Up to 20 swimmers will be selected.
- Swimming Canada's para points calculator will be used to score eligible athletes best long course times.
- Eligible Athletes will be ranked using their best three-event point score, with a total of at least 900 points.
 - SB9-only swimmers will be scored by tripling their SB9 score.
- Each province may select their top two swimmers regardless of overall rank or gender.
 - In the event a provinces top ranked swimmer declines, the province may select the next ranked eligible swimmer
- The remaining twelve selections will be ranked and selected regardless of province or gender. Alternates will be ranked regardless of province or gender.

Coaches

- All personal coaches are encouraged to attend.
 - The Canadian Paralympic Committee has provided a grant to cover all coaches' expenses, including transportation, meals and accommodations.

Selection Timelines

- October 31 – Camp Selections Distributed
- November 15 – Selection Deadline
- November 30 – Final Selections Confirmed (including alternates)
