



I Can Swim Teacher - Evaluation Requirements

Many requirements are in place to manage the evaluation process for I Can Swim Teacher Candidates. Please be aware of and adhere to the following requirements:

- *Candidates* must assist an *I Can Swim Assessor* (a certified *I Can Swim Teacher* or *NCCP-certified Swim Coach*) in teaching a minimum of 2.5 hours of lessons (e.g., 5 x 30-minute lessons.)
- *Candidates* must then lead a minimum of 2.5 hours of lessons under the direct supervision of an *I Can Swim Assessor*.

Please Note: *Candidates do not have to teach with/be observed by the same I Can Swim Assessor for the entire 5 hours.*

- *Candidates* are required to submit lesson plans to their *I Can Swim Assessor(s)* for all unassisted classes within their practical teaching.
- To help assist the *Candidate* with a successful final evaluation outcome, it's advisable for the *I Can Swim Assessor(s)* to give the *Candidate* feedback both on their lesson plans and teaching abilities for the lessons they are leading. Please refer to the Competency Assessment to aid with this process.
- *Candidates* must have their supervising *I Can Swim Assessor* sign their Practical Teaching Experience Record before submitting a copy of this to the *I Can Swim Evaluator*.
